

Primary Angelico Exhibition 2017 Important Points to Note

All entries are to be entered online.

1. Teachers need to go to the Catholic Arts Office website www.catholicarts.wa.edu.au
 2. Click on the 'Angelico' Tab
 3. Complete Registration Form
 4. Upload your photo
 5. SUBMIT
- It is a requirement for the General Category Labels A, B & C to be completed and attached to the artwork.
 - Submission of Artwork: Maximum of 6 pieces of artwork per school. **Please note: as this is the first primary exhibition, there is a possibility that the number of entries per school may be reduced dependent on the number of entries received by schools. Schools will be advised if this occurs.**
 - Works nominated for Fra Angelico will automatically be entered into the General Category. Students must tick the relevant nomination box on the Registration Label to have their work judged for this award and works must reflect the Award Criteria.
 - A Group Submission Category is available for Pre-Primary to Year 6. Please see guidelines for entry criteria.
 - Artwork must be delivered to the Catholic Arts office between Mon July 17 and Wed July 19. Office hours are strictly 8am to 4pm.
 - 2D Artworks dropped off to the Catholic Arts Office must be wrapped or placed in folios
 - 3D Artworks must be bubble wrapped and boxed where necessary

- Fragile pieces or artworks that require assembling are to be transported by the teacher / student on the day of set up to Forrest Centre. The committee will not take responsibility for the setup of these submissions.
- Artworks are to be collected by the schools at the completion of the exhibition from the Catholic Arts Office from Wednesday 16 – Friday 18 August between 8am – 4pm.
- Hanging devices must be correctly placed on artwork. **Velcro is to be used only on paper/card artworks and canvas works must be fitted with wire hanging devices.**
- Award winners will be invited to attend the opening night presentation of the Secondary Angelico Exhibition on Tuesday 15th August to receive their prize and must attend in their full winter school uniform.

Primary Angelico Exhibition 2017 Guidelines

Online submission of entry

- Entries are to be submitted online with a photo uploaded. (See Important Points to Note).
- Students are encouraged to title their artwork as this enhances the viewer's understanding of, and interest in, the work.
- Works nominated for Fra Angelico Award will automatically be entered into the General Category. Students must tick the nomination box on the Online Entry and Registration Label (attached to artwork) to have their work judged for this award.
- Year levels are Pre Primary – Year 2 and Years 3 - 6
- Students must be aware that the online entry provides authorisation for the reproduction of artwork images in publications and on the Catholic Arts/Catholic Education websites.
- Closing date for online entries is **Friday 23 June, 2017**

Delivery of Artwork

- All art must be submitted to the Catholic Arts Office, Newman Siena Centre, 33 Williamstown Road, Doubleview **between Monday, July 17 and Wednesday, July 19. Office hours are strictly 8am to 4pm.** (A location map is attached)
- General Category Labels A, B & C must be completed.
- No more than SIX (6) pieces of artwork per school can be submitted including ONE (1) Group submission per school
- Artwork must be packaged carefully and securely for transportation. **Fragile artwork must be securely packed (in a box) with an accompanying photograph on how it is to be displayed. The art teacher must take responsibility for the hanging of fragile pieces (or pieces that are difficult to display) on set-up day, Saturday 22nd July from 11.30am at Forrest Centre.**
- A photograph of each piece of artwork, in the way it is to be displayed, to be attached to the accompanying entry form.
- The General Category Label must be completed and authorised with the signature of the Art Teacher and Principal.

Presentation of Artwork

- No large artworks without prior approval from the committee. Works over 22kg will not be accepted.
- Paintings on stretch canvas must be of exhibition standard i.e. painted canvas edges.
- A mannequin to exhibition standard must be supplied for displaying textiles and jewellery.
- Artwork to be securely fixed to stop movement.
- Artwork labels will be produced by the Catholic Arts Office
- All work submitted must be the students own artwork.

Hanging of Artwork

- Please be aware that artworks will be displayed on Panel boards and plinths. There is no facility to hang pieces from the ceiling.
- 2D Artworks are to be **mounted on card or core board and have adequate velcro attached**. Mounts should have at least a 6cm frame and mount board can be any colour. Pre-cut frames may be used.
- Canvas artworks must be adequately wired and securely **attached with screws not tape**.

Please use the attached images as a guide



The Committee has the right to exclude a piece of work if not presented to exhibition standard.

Suitability of Artwork

It is the responsibility of Principals to sight the artworks prior to submission. Provision for the Principal and Art Teacher to 'sign off' on the artwork has been made on Label C (Registration Label) which must be submitted with each entry.

If there are any unusual artworks that require specialised display considerations, these must be identified with an accompanying photograph. If you are unsure please forward a photograph to the Committee for viewing prior to submitting online.

The Committee reserves the right to advise schools if a particular piece of work is deemed unsuitable for exhibition and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Group Submissions

Group submissions are to be entered as a separate category. One (1) group submission per school is permissible. Group submissions are not eligible to nominate for the Fra Angelico Award. Due to restrictions with the size of the venue, a maximum of 6 pieces are to be incorporated in the group submission. Consideration must be given to the size of the piece. Large/Heavy pieces will not be accepted. The photo uploaded with the online entry must reflect the way in which the pieces are to be displayed. Concerns regarding the display of a group submission must be directed to the Catholic Arts Office.

Judging

Winners will be notified via the school Principal.

Opening Night

All Award winners only from the Primary Exhibition will be invited to attend the Opening Night Presentation for the Secondary Angelico Exhibition on Tuesday 15 August at 6pm. An official invitation will also be forwarded to the Principal and Art Teachers from these respective schools.

Award winning students and four (4) family members are invited to attend the Opening Night – In the Group Submission Category, two (2) family members per participating students are invited to attend the Opening Night, due to space restrictions - RSVP's are imperative.

In the group submission category, one (1) representative (to be chosen by the Principal) will be invited on stage to receive their award at the Secondary Angelico Opening Night Presentation.

“Award Presentations”

Students receiving Awards at the Opening Night must be in full school uniform

The Award winning pieces will be exhibited at the secondary exhibition.

Photographs

There will be an official photographer at the Opening Night. Photos of artworks, winners and audience will be placed on the Catholic Arts website. If you do not wish to have your photo on the website or in any publications, please advise the Catholic Arts Office. You must also inform the photographer on the evening.

Entry Fee

To assist with covering costs a fee of \$10 per individual entry and \$20 per group submission will be charged. Invoices will be issued by the Catholic Arts Office. Please do not send money with artworks.

Promoting Angelico

Posters advertising the Angelico Exhibition will be sent to all primary schools.

Principals and art teachers are asked to actively promote the Exhibition within their school community. Schools are encouraged to contact their local newspaper regarding students' participation.

Visiting the Exhibition

Schools are encouraged to view the Exhibition at Forrest Centre during business hours (9.00am – 5.00pm) from Monday July 24 to Friday August 11.

Setting up

The knowledge and expertise of art teachers is invaluable in setting up the exhibition. This occurs on the Saturday morning (22nd July) prior to the opening of the Exhibition. Any assistance would be greatly appreciated.

Please be reminded that set up of any artworks that require specialised display consideration are the responsibility of the art teacher.

Collection of artworks

Artworks are to be collected from the Catholic Arts office between 8am-4pm, Wed 16 – Fri 18 August. Ample notice is being given to ensure planning for collection of the artworks is organised by the school.

- § Labels **A and B** to be attached to each piece of artwork.
- § Label **C** (Registration Label) will be collected by staff when artworks are delivered to the Catholic Arts Office, Newman Siena Centre, 33 Williamstown Road, Doubleview WA 6018. Delivery dates are between **Monday July 17 and Wednesday July 19.** **Office hours are strictly 8am – 4pm.**
- § The title of the artwork, student's name, year and school, to be clearly marked on Labels **A, B & C.**
(Do not rely on a painted signature as identification).
- § Please ensure that at the point of selection, all artwork submitted is supportive of Catholic values. It is the responsibility of the Principal to sight artworks prior to submission. Provision for the Principal and Art Teacher to '**sign off**' on artworks has been made on Label **C** (Registration Label).
